Recently, Harford County Schools upgraded a playground that was badly in need of surfacing but the maintenance department and other department heads at the school district wanted to do something that would increase access on their playgrounds and not bust their budget.



First they installed a combination of Woodcarpet® engineered wood fiber with wear mats under the slide exits to help with maintenance issues in these heavily tracked areas. These mats were anchored with Zeager's duckbill anchoring system to prevent movement and vandalism.

Next, Zeager's Bonded Woodcarpet® system was used for an accessible pathway into the play area and around the swing area which had 5 bays including 2 swings for special needs children.



The swing area was used to test a new product Zeager is looking to introduce in the near future to make large traffic areas such as swing bays



and multi-slide exits more accessible. The mat system uses polyvinyl matting over our interlocking foam panels. The nice thing about this mat system unlike other conventional wear mats is that we can create wear mats for just about any size high traffic area! In this particular case we could have installed our conventional foam wear mats made for below swings but the school system wanted something that covered each of the swing bays entirely.
